Open evening – Cardinal Wiseman

We are delighted to confirm that the Opening evening for our Romero Secondary partnered school, **Cardinal Wiseman** will be on **Wednesday 19th September 2018 from 6pm – 8pm**.

We invite you to hold this date if your child is currently in Year 5 (or Year 4), so that you can attend the evening, meet the staff and see the school in action. It will be an opportunity to meet the Principal, **Mr Leverage** who has been in post for a full academic year and is making significant progress in moving the school forward. Furthermore, the leadership team are significantly working on curriculum design, strengthening the teaching and learning to ensure consistency and raising expectations in all areas but notably in behaviour. In all seven Primary schools, we have appointed a Leading Practitioner, Mrs Scullion, who works across Romero supporting the children in this transition. Having worked with all children in Year 6, she then follows children up into Year 7 at Cardinal Wiseman to make sure the children have transferred smoothly and they have built on the foundations made in Romero Primary schools.

Please be advised that we know there is a significant increase in admissions for Secondary in September 2019 (for current Year 5) so it is vital that you make an informed, sensible choice to ensure that you can successfully secure a place for your child. We also ask that you make sure you exercise your right to select three schools in order of preference.

We know that historically, a small group of parents have selected just one school, and then if that choice has not been successful in securing a place for their child, they have been placed in a school with vacancies that can be some distance from your home.
