This will then allow you to join the event and you will be placed in the lobby area. When it's your allocated time that you have booked, the class teacher will then allow you into the meeting. Please be patient as there may be delays. You will need to ensure that your Microphone and Cameras are on, so you can interact with the class teachers.



Changes for Drift-In


