Dear parents, children, staff and parishioners,

Returning to school from 8th March 2021

Over the past few months, the circumstances around the lock down has been a challenge for everyone: children, young people, parents/carers, and school staff. Normal life has been disrupted, yet again. There are still many challenges ahead, but we are slowly starting to see light at the end of the tunnel with the Government's Road-Map.

The number of cases has reduced significantly and so the Government has now asked all schools to plan for all children and young people, in all year groups, to return to school from Monday 8th March 2021.


Go Parks Challenge - 2 DAYS TO GO! LET'S GO TEAM SH




