Earlier this week, we were notified that Mr Gerry Campbell (Headteacher of Sacred Heart in the 80s and 90s), sadly passed away in Coventry. He was a well-respected man and cared so much for Sacred Heart school and the parish community.

Below are a few messages and memories of Gerry and the wonderful contribution he made as headteacher of Sacred Heart.

"Gerry was my headteacher when I attended Sacred Heart in the 80s. I remember him for being a generous and funny man, always putting the children first. You would walk into his office to be greeted with a sea of smoke in the air and he always had treats! He will be sadly missed." Mr Madia

"In his early days of teaching, Gerry taught PE at Secondary School. When he became Headteacher of Sacred Heart Primary School, he would always timetable himself to take the Reception class for PE; that way, he would get to know each child. I recall walking by the school hall where a lesson had just finished, and the children were laying on their backs with their feet in the air whilst Gerry went around the hall helping them to put on their socks. He really enjoyed these sessions!" Mary Wilson (Ex headteacher of Sacred Heart)

"Gerry was a caring and supportive head for staff and pupils. He always had time to listen and try to resolve any problems especially regarding family - family came first. When retired he enjoyed playing golf at the Windmill and would laugh talking about the old times" Catrina Madia (Ex Teaching Assistant)




