Infection Control & Medication

Please can we remind all parents that no medication should be sent into school directly with your child without completing a medicine form and handing it into the office with the medication. Also at this time of year when there are all sorts of bugs, germs and viruses around, in order to minimise the spreading of illnesses we ask parents to consider whether your child is well enough to attend school. Reminder – if a child has had sickness or diarrhoea they must not attend school for at least 48 hours since the last occurrence. Can we remind you that medicines in school must be prescribed by a GP.
