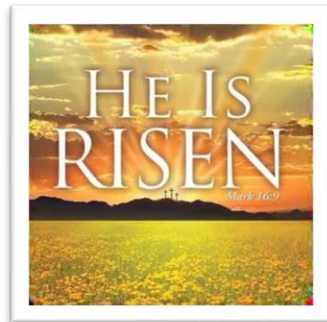
Dear parents, children, staff and parishioners,

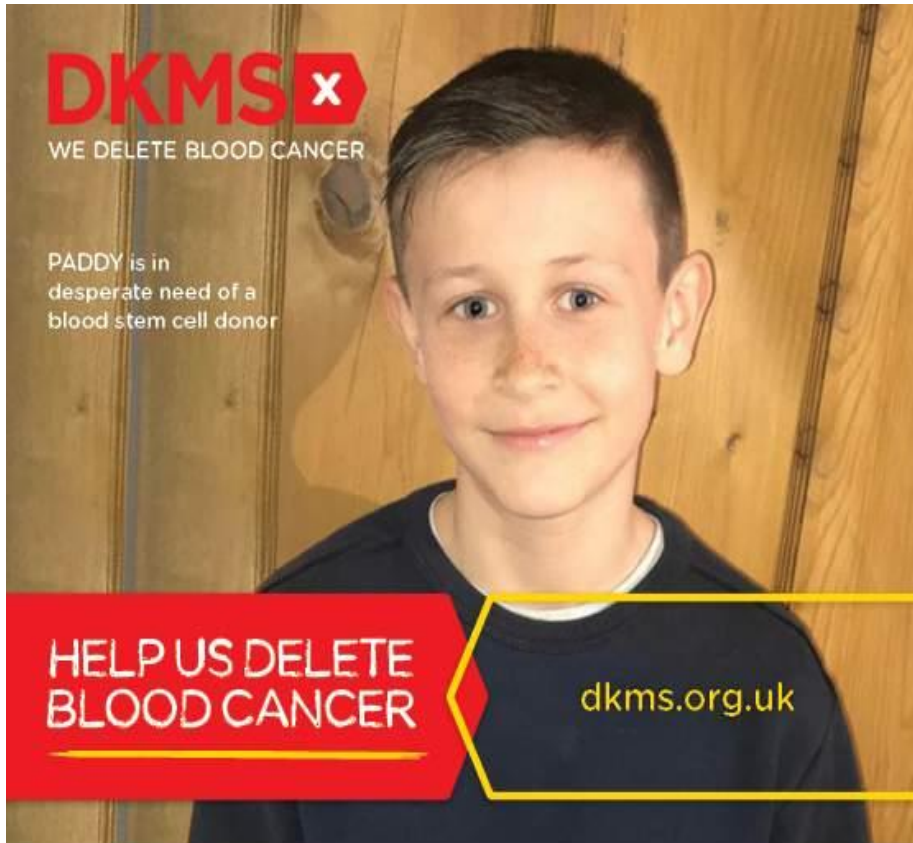

As many of you will now be aware from our Facebook Campaign, Mrs Donna Igoe's family are currently in crisis (she is one of our Reception Teachers). You should have been notified on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April if you have been successful in gaining a Reception place at Sacred Heart. The Academy Committee have ranked all the applications for Rising Fives this year and places have been allocated according to our Admissions Policy in line with the Admissions code. This year we had 153 applications for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> places. There is a waiting list, but the Academy Committee are bound by the Code to offer any places, should they become available in the future, according to the criteria.
