## Pupil Progress Report

We are also including the **attendance data** for the whole year detailing which children have met the target of 97% attendance. All documents will be presented in a sealed envelope and given to your child to take home at the end of the day. We would be grateful if you could send back your comment slip for your child's school file. Thank you.

## End of Year Data/Attendance

On the same day (Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July) we will be sending home your children's end of year data, detailing if your child is working at the expected level, at a greater depth or working toward to expected level. Children in Year 6/Year 2 will also be bringing home their SATs results. Children in Year 1 and Year 2 will bring home their results from their phonics tests. These results will be carried forward into the next year group, ready for September 2019. Well done to all the children for working so hard over the past year – we are very proud of you. 😊
