School Meals

Our kitchen staff have been busy in our kitchen designing a hot meal menu. We can confirm that ALL options are very tasty indeed! We take daily orders, therefore, if your child likes the look of a particular dish, why not let them order a school meal for that day? All they need to do is inform their teacher that they would like a school meal during registration and make their selection. You can then pay for this meal via our Arbor App. Meals are currently priced at £2.22 and also include fruit or cake of the day and a drink.
