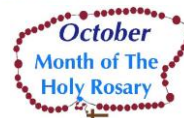

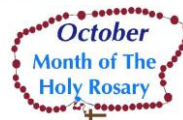

Primary Admissions for Reception September 2022 - Rising Fives

If you have a child whose birthday falls between **01.09.2017 and 31.08.2018** you need to apply now for a primary school place for your child in September 2022. Apply online at www.coventry.gov.uk/admissions. Closing date for applications is **15th January 2022**. Please note the Admissions Policy and how the places are allocated. Priority is given to baptised Catholics as we are a Catholic school.

Virtual Consultations on Wednesday 20th October (see Arbor message)



The Virtual Consultations for Year N to Year 6 are now available to book in 10 minute slots on Arbor. On the home page, click Virtual Consultations; Click the child's name then; Click on the chosen time slot; and then confirm a time, any problems please contact the office. Times: 1:00pm – 6:45pm.

Times will be strict and you will only be allocated 10 minutes – once this time has come to an end the meeting will close automatically.

TEAMS - You do not need to download any TEAMS Apps as the link will work in a normal internet browser. Please click on the TEAMS link in your email inbox and click on JOIN. This will then allow you to join the event and you will be placed in the lobby area. When it's your allocated time that you have booked, the class teacher will then allow you into the meeting.

Please be patient as there may be delays. You will need to ensure that your Microphone and Cameras are on, so you can interact with the class teachers.

Winter Uniform

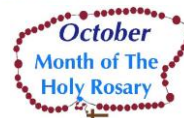

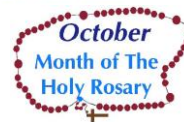
