Pupil Progress Report

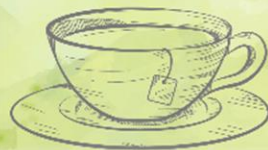
Sacred Heart Wellbeing coffee morning Friday 8th July 9-10am
